

Year 1 – Working at Home Grid

All Creatures Great and Small	Children should be heard reading daily. Children can continue to practise their spellings using words from previous weeks.
Maths	<p>Practise counting in 2s, 5s or 10s. You could use different items (toy cars, dolls/teddies etc) from around your home to help you!</p> <p>Write your number bonds to 10, then write them to 20. What patterns do you notice?</p> <p>Pick 6 numbers from 0 to 100. Can you draw them using diennes? Partition the numbers and write how many tens and one (e.g. 56 is 5 tens and 6 ones). Can you find one more and one less? Are they odd or even?</p>
Writing	<p>Write an acrostic poem about the seasons. You could pick one season to focus on or write about them all. Remember to use adjectives to describe!</p> <p>Draw a story map of a book, you could use your reading book or a book from home. Could you come up with actions to show the class?</p> <p>Practise writing the alphabet and your name in your best handwriting. Can you get your writing on the line? Have you got clear ascenders (tall letters such as b or t) or descenders (letters that are below the line such as g or y)?</p>
Combined Studies	<p>Draw or make a model of the human body. Can you label the different parts of the body?</p> <p>Research different animals. Are they herbivores, carnivores or omnivores? Where do they live and how have they adapted to live there?</p> <p>Draw or paint a tree in the different seasons. What colours would you use for autumn or winter? How does the tree change through the seasons?</p>
